A BILL

To amend sections 5534.817, 5534.893, 5534.894, and 1
5534.895 and to enact sections 5534.014, 2
5534.407, 5534.408, 5534.60, 5534.601, 5534.602, 3
5534.752, 5534.79, 5534.807, 5534.812, 5534.814, 4
5534.818, 5534.822, 5534.823, 5534.824, 5
5534.825, 5534.826, 5534.827, 5534.829, 6
5534.833, 5534.834, 5534.871, 5534.881, 7
5534.882, 5534.883, 5534.884, 5534.885, 8
5534.886, 5534.887, 5534.888, 5534.89, 5534.896, 9
5534.898, 5534.91, 5534.913, and 5534.916 of the 10
Revised Code to designate and change the name 11
and location of multiple memorial highways and 12
bridges. 13

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 5534.817, 5534.893, 5534.894, and 14
5534.895 be amended and sections 5534.014, 5534.407, 5534.408, 15
5534.60, 5534.601, 5534.602, 5534.752, 5534.79, 5534.807, 16
5534.812, 5534.814, 5534.818, 5534.822, 5534.823, 5534.824, 17
5534.825, 5534.826, 5534.827, 5534.829, 5534.833, 5534.834, 18
5534.871, 5534.881, 5534.882, 5534.883, 5534.884, 5534.885, 19
5534.886, 5534.887, 5534.888, 5534.89, 5534.896, 5534.898, 20
5534.91, 5534.913, and 5534.916 of the Revised Code be enacted 21
to read as follows: 22

Sec. 5534.014. In addition to any other name prescribed by 23
the Revised Code or otherwise, the road known as state route 24
number one hundred twenty-two, running in an easterly and 25
westerly direction, commencing at the intersection of that route 26
and Wicoff street in Butler county and extending to the 27
intersection of that route and Towne boulevard in Warren county, 28
shall be known as the "SFC Charles E. Carpenter Memorial 29
Highway." 30

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 31
along the highway indicating its name. 32

Sec. 5534.407. In addition to any other name prescribed by 33
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 34
of state route number two between the intersection of that route 35
and state route number three hundred six and the intersection of 36
that route and state route number six hundred fifteen, in Lake 37
county, shall be known as the "Patrolman Mathew Mazany Memorial 38
Highway." 39

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 40
along the highway indicating its name. 41

Sec. 5534.408. In addition to any other name prescribed in 42

the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 43
lanes of state route number seven between state route number 44
eighty-two and state route number three hundred five, in 45
Trumbull county, shall be known as the "Patrolman James A. 46
Fredericka Memorial Highway." 47

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 48
along the highway indicating its name. 49

Sec. 5534.60. In addition to any other name prescribed in 50
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 51
lanes of United States route number sixty-two between Staunton- 52
Sugar Grove road and Greenfield Sabina road, in Fayette county, 53
shall be known as the "PFC William Boggs, CPL Sam Boggs, and SGT 54
Robert Boggs Memorial Highway." 55

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 56
along the highway indicating its name. 57

Sec. 5534.601. In addition to any other name prescribed in 58
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 59
lanes of state route number one hundred eight between the 60
southern border of Henry county and the northern border of Henry 61
county shall be known as the "RDML Alene Duerk Memorial 62
Highway." 63

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 64
along the highway indicating its name. 65

Sec. 5534.602. In addition to any other name prescribed in 66
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 67
lanes of state route number sixty-six between Houston road and 68
Roeth road, in Shelby county, shall be known as the "SFC Charles 69
Gregory Huston Memorial Highway." 70

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 71

along the highway indicating its name. 72

Sec. 5534.752. The bridge spanning the Maumee river in 73
Henry county and being a part of the highway known as state 74
route one hundred nine shall be known as the "Damascus Bridge." 75

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 76
upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 77

Sec. 5534.79. The eastbound lanes of interstate route 78
number seventy between the intersection of that route and 79
interstate route number seventy-one and the intersection of 80
interstate route number seventy and the James road exit, in 81
Franklin county, shall be known as the "Justice Robert Duncan 82
Memorial Highway." 83

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 84
along the highway indicating its name. 85

Sec. 5534.807. In addition to any other name prescribed by 86
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 87
of state route number sixty-three between the intersection of 88
that route with state route number seven hundred forty-one and 89
the intersection of that route with Neil Armstrong way, in 90
Warren county only, shall be known as the "SFC John E. Conger, 91
Jr. Memorial Highway." 92

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 93
along the highway indicating its name. 94

Sec. 5534.812. In addition to any other name prescribed in 95
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 96
lanes of interstate route number four hundred seventy-five 97
between hill avenue and state route number two, in Lucas county 98
only, shall be known as the "SGT Alex Drabik Memorial Highway." 99

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 100
along the highway indicating its name. 101

Sec. 5534.814. The bridge spanning Grand river that is a 102
part of Fairport road and that is a primary entrance and exit to 103
Fairport Harbor, in Lake county, shall be known as the "Col. 104
Donald Blakeslee Memorial Bridge." 105

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 106
upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 107

Sec. 5534.817. In addition to any other name prescribed in 108
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 109
lanes of interstate route number seventy-one between the 110
intersections of that route with interstate route number two 111
hundred seventy and United States route number thirty-six, in 112
Franklin and Delaware counties, shall be known as the "Marine 113
PFC LCpl Jacob Spann Memorial Highway." 114

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 115
along the highway indicating its name. 116

Sec. 5534.818. In addition to any other name prescribed in 117
the Revised Code or otherwise, that portion of the road known as 118
state route number one hundred fifty-two, running in a northerly 119
and southerly direction between the intersection of that route 120
with county road fifty-six and the intersection of that route 121
with township road two hundred forty-nine, in Jefferson county 122
only, shall be known as the "PFC George Dennis McClelland 123
Memorial Highway." 124

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 125
along the highway indicating its name. 126

Sec. 5534.822. In addition to any other name prescribed by 127
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 128

lanes of interstate route number seventy-one between state mile 129
marker twenty-two and state mile marker twenty-three in Warren 130
county shall be known as the "Veterans Suicide Memorial Mile." 131

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 132
along the highway indicating its name. 133

Sec. 5534.823. In addition to any other name prescribed by 134
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 135
of state route number one hundred twenty-five, between mile 136
marker four and mile marker five, in Brown county only, shall be 137
known as the "PFC M. Preston Wheeler Memorial Highway." 138

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 139
along the highway indicating its name. 140

Sec. 5534.824. In addition to any other name prescribed in 141
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 142
lanes of state route number sixty-five between the intersection 143
of that route and state route number sixty-four and the 144
intersection of that route and the western border of Wood 145
county, in Wood county only, shall be known as the "Master Chief 146
Special Warfare Operator (SEAL) Edward C. Byers, Jr. Medal of 147
Honor Recipient Highway." 148

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 149
along the highway indicating its name. 150

Sec. 5534.825. In addition to any other name prescribed in 151
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 152
lanes of state route number twenty-five between the intersection 153
of that route and United States route number twenty and the 154
intersection of that route and United States route number 155
twenty-three, in Wood county only, shall be known as the "SGT 156
Arthur A. Mora, Jr. Memorial Highway." 157

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 158
along the highway indicating its name. 159

Sec. 5534.826. In addition to any other name prescribed in 160
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 161
of United States route number thirty-six between the 162
intersection of that route and the western border of Coshocton 163
county and the intersection of that route and state route number 164
seventy-nine, in Coshocton county only, shall be known as the 165
"Charles C. Nichols Memorial Highway." 166

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 167
along the highway indicating its name. 168

Sec. 5534.827. In addition to any other name prescribed by 169
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 170
of state route number four hundred twenty-two between the 171
intersection of that route and state route number six hundred 172
sixteen and the intersection of that route and the border of 173
Pennsylvania, in Mahoning county, shall be known as the "PFC 174
Ronald J. Puskarcik Memorial Highway." 175

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 176
along the highway indicating its name. 177

Sec. 5534.829. In addition to any other name prescribed by 178
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 179
of state route number thirty-nine, between the intersection of 180
that route and United States route number sixty-two near the 181
municipal corporation of Berlin, Ohio and the intersection of 182
that route and Joet road, in Holmes county, shall be known as 183
the "Cpl. Fredrick Wayne Miller Memorial Highway." 184

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 185
along the highway indicating its name. 186

Sec. 5534.833. In addition to any other name prescribed by 187
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 188
of state route number two hundred sixty-one, between the 189
intersection of that route and home avenue and the intersection 190
of that route where it joins north main street, in the municipal 191
corporation of Akron in Summit county, shall be known as the 192
"Cpl. Andrew D. Brownfield Memorial Highway." 193

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 194
along the highway indicating its name. 195

Sec. 5534.834. In addition to any other name prescribed by 196
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 197
lanes of state route number seventy-two between the intersection 198
of that route and Wilmington road and the intersection of that 199
route and United States route number thirty-five, in Greene 200
county only, shall be known as the "LCpl David E. Morton 201
Memorial Highway." 202

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 203
along the highway indicating its name. 204

Sec. 5534.871. In addition to any other name prescribed in 205
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 206
of state route number five hundred fifty between the 207
intersection of that route and Barnett ridge road and the 208
intersection of that route and stone quarry road, in Washington 209
county, shall be known as the "SGT Meredith L. Barnett Memorial 210
Highway." 211

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 212
along the highway indicating its name. 213

Sec. 5534.881. In addition to any other name prescribed in 214
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 215

lanes of state route number ninety-nine between the intersection 216
of that route and county road number sixty-four and the 217
intersection of that route and county road number one hundred 218
nineteen, in Huron county, shall be known as the "Lance Corporal 219
James Sprowl Memorial Highway." 220

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 221
along the highway indicating its name. 222

Sec. 5534.882. In addition to any other name prescribed in 223
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 224
lanes of state route number forty-eight between east Stroop road 225
and east Dorothy lane, in the municipal corporation of Kettering 226
in Montgomery county, shall be known as the "CWO3 James E. 227
Groves III Memorial Highway." 228

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 229
along the highway indicating its name. 230

Sec. 5534.883. In addition to any other name prescribed in 231
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 232
lanes of United States route number twenty-three between mile 233
marker six and mile marker eight, within Ross county, shall be 234
known as the "SGT Michael Keith Hamner Memorial Highway." 235

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 236
along the highway indicating its name. 237

Sec. 5534.884. In addition to any other name prescribed in 238
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 239
lanes of state route number sixty-five between county road H and 240
state route number one hundred ten, in Henry county, shall be 241
known as the "LTC Kevin Sonnenberg Memorial Highway." 242

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 243
along the highway indicating its name. 244

Sec. 5534.885. The bridge spanning state route number 245
eleven, located in Canfield township in Mahoning county, and 246
being part of the highway known as United States route number 247
two hundred twenty-four, shall be known as the "Canfield Armed 248
Forces Bridge." 249

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 250
upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 251

Sec. 5534.886. The bridge spanning interstate route number 252
seventy-six, located in Canfield township in Mahoning county, 253
and being part of the road known as Herbert road, shall be known 254
as the "Canfield First Responders Bridge." 255

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 256
upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 257

Sec. 5534.887. The bridge spanning interstate route number 258
seventy-six, located in Canfield township in Mahoning county, 259
and being part of the highway known as state route number forty- 260
six, shall be known as the "Lewis John Speece, Jr. Memorial 261
Bridge." 262

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 263
upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 264

Sec. 5534.888. In addition to any other name prescribed by 265
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 266
of United States route number six, between the intersection of 267
that route and Frailey road and the intersection of that route 268
and Hahn road, in Erie county, shall be known as the "SGT 269
Theodore Ward Memorial Highway." 270

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 271
along the highway indicating its name. 272

Sec. 5534.89. (A) In addition to any other name prescribed 273
in the Revised Code or otherwise, the portion of the road known 274
as state route number fifty-three, commencing at the 275
intersection of that route and water street and proceeding in a 276
southerly direction to the Catawba island township line in 277
Ottawa county shall be known as the "Catawba Island Township 278
Veterans Memorial Highway." 279

(B) The director of transportation may erect suitable 280
markers along the highway indicating its name. 281

(C) Subject to approval by the director in relation to the 282
marker location, size, color, format, and method of placement, 283
the Catawba island township board of trustees may erect 284
auxiliary markers in conjunction with the markers erected by the 285
director under division (B) of this section, displaying the 286
following names and any other name of a United States military 287
veteran approved by the board: 288

(1) Private First Class William E. Galloway; 289

(2) SP4 James M. Davenport. 290

The Catawba island township board of trustees may 291
alternate the approved auxiliary markers on a periodic basis. 292

Sec. 5534.893. In addition to any other name in the 293
Revised Code or otherwise, the ~~northbound~~ eastbound and 294
~~southbound~~ westbound lanes of United States route number thirty- 295
three between ~~McCalla township road~~ number ninety-four and 296
township road number ~~ninety-nine~~ two hundred twenty-one, in Logan 297
county only, shall be known as the "Army Staff Sgt. Dennis J. 298
Hansen Memorial Highway." 299

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 300
along the highway indicating its name. 301

Sec. 5534.894. In addition to any other name in the 302
Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound lanes 303
of United States route number ~~thirty-three~~ sixty-eight between 304
township road number ~~ninety-nine~~ thirty-seven and ~~county-~~ 305
township road number one hundred ~~thirtythree~~, in Logan county 306
only, shall be known as the "Army National Guard Sgt. Jeremy M. 307
Hodge Memorial Highway." 308

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 309
along the highway indicating its name. 310

Sec. 5534.895. In addition to any other name in the 311
Revised Code or otherwise, the ~~northbound~~ eastbound and 312
~~southbound~~ westbound lanes of United States route number thirty- 313
three between ~~east Sandusky avenue~~ state route number five 314
hundred forty and ~~county road~~ state route number five two hundred 315
ninety-two, in Logan county only, shall be known as the "Marine 316
Gunnery Sgt. David S. Spicer Memorial Highway." 317

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 318
along the highway indicating its name. 319

Sec. 5534.896. The bridge that is part of state route 320
number six hundred three, located in the village of Plymouth in 321
Huron and Richland counties, and being a part of the road known 322
as Trux street, shall be known as the "Trucks Bridge." 323

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 324
upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 325

Sec. 5534.898. In addition to any other name prescribed by 326
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 327
lanes of state route number four between the intersection of 328
that route and Owens road west and the intersection of that 329
route and Somerlot Hoffman road west, in Marion county only, 330

shall be known as the "SGT David S. Harris Memorial Highway." 331

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 332
along the highway indicating its name. 333

Sec. 5534.91. In addition to any other name prescribed in 334
the Revised Code or otherwise, the southbound lane of interstate 335
route number seventy-one commencing at mile marker one hundred 336
two and continuing to mile marker one hundred, in Franklin 337
county, shall be known as the "James H. Hough Memorial Highway." 338

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 339
along the highway indicating its name. 340

Sec. 5534.913. In addition to any other name prescribed in 341
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 342
lanes of interstate route number two hundred seventy-one between 343
South Woodland road and Harvard road, in Cuyahoga county, shall 344
be known as the "Ronald H. Barron Memorial Highway." 345

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 346
along the highway indicating its name. 347

Sec. 5534.916. In addition to any other name prescribed in 348
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 349
of United States route number twenty-two, between the 350
intersection of that route and state route number one hundred 351
eighty-eight and the intersection of that route number and state 352
route number thirty-seven, in Fairfield county, shall be known 353
as the "Officer M. Scott Moyer Memorial Highway." 354

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 355
along the highway indicating its name. 356

Section 2. That existing sections 5534.817, 5534.893, 357
5534.894, and 5534.895 of the Revised Code are hereby repealed. 358
