To enact sections 5.2316, 5.2521, 5.2522, 5.2525,
and 5.293 of the Revised Code to make multiple
special designations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 5.2316, 5.2521, 5.2522, 5.2525,
and 5.293 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 5.2316. The month of May is designated as "Preeclampsia Awareness Month" to increase public awareness of this disorder, characterized by a sudden increase in the mother's blood pressure after the twentieth week of pregnancy, that may result in serious and life-threatening complications including poor fetal growth, preterm birth, and organ damage to the mother.

Sec. 5.2521. The twenty-sixth day of April is designated as "Diabetic Ketoacidosis (DKA) Awareness Day."

Sec. 5.2522. The month of March is designated as "Bleeding Disorders Awareness Month" to increase public awareness of

bleeding disorders, which are rare genetic disorders that 17
prevent the blood from clotting properly, and to encourage the 18
enhancement of care and treatment options available for patients 19
