The amount reappropriated from the foregoing appropriation 21 item C725E2, Local Parks, Recreation, and Conservation Projects, 22 shall be equal to the amount of all unreleased local parks 23 projects and allowable administrative costs specified in this 24 section, unless amounts are released prior to June 30, 2020. 25 Prior to the expenditure of this appropriation, the Department 26 of Natural Resources shall certify to the Director of Budget and 27 Management canceled encumbrances in the amount of at least 28 \$52,144. 29

Of the foregoing appropriation item C725E2, Local Parks,30Recreation, and Conservation Projects, an amount equal to two31per cent of the projects listed may be used by the Department of32Natural Resources for the administration of local projects.33

Section 5. That existing Sections 207.26, 223.10, and35223.15 of H.B. 481 of the 133rd General Assembly are hereby36repealed.37

Section 6. The Treasurer of State is hereby authorized to 38 issue and sell, in accordance with Section 2i of Article VIII, 39 Ohio Constitution, and Chapter 154. of the Revised Code, 40 particularly section 154.22, and other applicable sections of 41 the Revised Code, original obligations in an aggregate principal 42 amount not to exceed \$550,000, in addition to the original 43 issuance of obligations heretofore authorized by prior acts of 44 the General Assembly.
