A BILL

To enact sections 5534.415, 5534.417, 5534.418, 1
5534.421, 5534.511, 5534.54, 5534.819, 5534.821, 2
5534.828, 5534.835, 5534.836, 5534.837, 3
5534.838, 5534.872, 5534.899, 5534.912, 4
5534.914, 5534.915, and 5534.921 of the Revised 5
Code to designate a portion of Interstate Route 6
275 in Hamilton County as the "Officer Kaia L. 7
Grant Memorial Highway" and make other memorial 8
designations. 9

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 5534.415, 5534.417, 5534.418, 10
5534.421, 5534.511, 5534.54, 5534.819, 5534.821, 5534.828, 11
5534.835, 5534.836, 5534.837, 5534.838, 5534.872, 5534.899, 12
5534.912, 5534.914, 5534.915, and 5534.921 of the Revised Code 13
be enacted to read as follows: 14

Sec. 5534.415. In addition to any other name prescribed by 15

the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 16
of interstate route number two hundred seventy-five between the 17
intersection of that route and Winton road and the intersection 18
of that route and interstate route number seventy-five, in 19
Hamilton county, shall be known as the "Officer Kaia L. Grant 20
Memorial Highway." 21

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 22
along the highway indicating its name. 23

Sec. 5534.417. In addition to any other name prescribed by 24
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 25
of interstate route number ninety, between mile marker sixty- 26
nine and mile marker seventy-one, in Wood county, shall be known 27
as the "Sergeant Frederick A. Raby Highway." 28

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 29
along the highway indicating its name. 30

Sec. 5534.418. In addition to any other name prescribed by 31
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 32
of state route number three hundred nine, between the 33
intersection of that route and Marion-Williamsport road west and 34
the intersection of that route and Holland road, in Marion 35
county, shall be known as the "Deputy Sheriff Bill Bender and 36
Trooper Randy Bender Memorial Highway." 37

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 38
along the highway indicating its name. 39

Sec. 5534.421. The overpass spanning state route number 40
fifteen, located in Hancock county and being a part of the 41
highway known as state route number thirty-seven, shall be known 42
as the "Patrolman David L. Sterner Memorial Overpass." 43

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 44

upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 45

Sec. 5534.511. In addition to any other name prescribed by 46
the Revised Code or otherwise, the portion of state route number 47
one hundred seventy, running in a northwesterly and 48
southeasterly direction, between the intersection of that route 49
and east western reserve road and the intersection of that route 50
and Dobbins road, in Mahoning county, shall be known as the 51
"State Representative Don Manning Memorial Highway." 52

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 53
along the highway indicating its name. 54

Sec. 5534.54. In addition to any other name prescribed in 55
the Revised Code or otherwise, the portion of the road known as 56
United States route number thirty-six between the intersection 57
of that route and county road number sixty-two and the 58
intersection of that route and county road number four hundred 59
sixteen, in Tuscarawas county, shall be known as the "Robert E. 60
Turney Memorial Highway." 61

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 62
along the highway indicating its name. 63

Sec. 5534.819. In addition to any other name prescribed in 64
the Revised Code or otherwise, the portion of the road known as 65
United States route number fifty-two running in an easterly and 66
westerly direction across the entire southern portion of Adams 67
county shall be known as the "Adams County Vietnam Veterans 68
Memorial Highway." 69

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 70
along the highway indicating its name. 71

Sec. 5534.821. (A) In addition to any other name 72
prescribed in the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and 73

southbound lanes of state route number sixty-six between the 74
southern border of Defiance county and the northern border of 75
Defiance county shall be known as the "Purple Heart Trail of 76
Defiance County." 77

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 78
along the highway indicating its name. 79

(B) The bridge spanning the Maumee river, located in the 80
municipal corporation of Defiance in Defiance county and being a 81
part of the highway known as state route number sixty-six, shall 82
be known as the "Purple Heart Bridge." 83

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 84
upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name. 85

Sec. 5534.828. In addition to any other name prescribed by 86
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 87
of interstate route number seventy-six between mile marker 88
number forty-four and mile marker number forty-five, in Portage 89
county only, shall be known as the "CPL Benjamin C. Dillon 90
Memorial Highway." 91

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 92
along the highway indicating its name. 93

Sec. 5534.835. In addition to any other name prescribed in 94
the Revised Code or otherwise, the portion of the road known as 95
state route number seven hundred forty-three, running in a 96
northerly and southerly direction, between the intersection of 97
that route and state route number two hundred twenty-two and the 98
intersection of that route and the location where the road spans 99
big indian creek, in Clermont county only, shall be known as the 100
"SGT Richard E. Wagner Memorial Highway." 101

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 102

along the highway indicating its name. 103

Sec. 5534.836. In addition to any other name prescribed in 104
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 105
of United States route number two hundred twenty-four, between 106
the eastern border of Putnam county and the western border of 107
Putnam county, shall be known as the "Putnam County Veterans 108
Memorial Highway." 109

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 110
along the highway indicating its name. 111

Sec. 5534.837. In addition to any other name prescribed in 112
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 113
of state route number seven hundred ninety-five between Tracy 114
road and north Fostoria road, located in Lake township in Wood 115
county, shall be known as the "Lake Township Veterans Memorial 116
Highway." 117

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 118
along the highway indicating its name. 119

Sec. 5534.838. In addition to any other name prescribed by 120
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 121
lanes of state route number one hundred fifty-eight, between the 122
intersection of that route and Ginder road northwest and the 123
intersection of that route and Carroll Eastern road northwest, 124
in Fairfield county, shall be known as the "SGT Joseph P. 125
Collette Memorial Highway." 126

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 127
along the highway indicating its name. 128

Sec. 5534.872. In addition to any other name prescribed in 129
the Revised Code or otherwise, the portion of the road known as 130
state route number sixty, running in a northwesterly and 131

southeasterly direction, between the intersection of that route 132
and county road number one hundred twenty-one and the 133
intersection of that route and county road number eighty-seven, 134
in Washington county, shall be known as the "U.S. Army 135
Specialist Christian D. Ward Memorial Highway." 136

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 137
along the highway indicating its name. 138

Sec. 5534.899. In addition to any other name prescribed by 139
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 140
lanes of state route number thirteen between the northern border 141
of the municipal corporation of Bellville to the southern border 142
of the municipal corporation of Mansfield, in Richland county 143
only, shall be known as the "PFC Steven D. Smith Memorial 144
Highway." 145

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 146
along the highway indicating its name. 147

Sec. 5534.912. In addition to any other name prescribed by 148
the Revised Code or otherwise, the portion of the road known as 149
state route number eight hundred, running in a northerly and 150
southerly direction, between the intersection of that route and 151
Ross Kennon road and the intersection of that route and Shannon 152
road, in Belmont county, shall be known as the "Steven Lowell 153
Cook Memorial Highway." 154

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 155
along the highway indicating its name. 156

Sec. 5534.914. In addition to any other name prescribed by 157
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 158
lanes of state route number thirteen, between the intersection 159
of that route and Lexington road and the intersection of that 160

route and Beckley road, in Knox county, shall be known as the 161
"William 'Bill' Burgett Memorial Highway." 162

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 163
along the highway indicating its name. 164

Sec. 5534.915. In addition to any other name prescribed in 165
the Revised Code or otherwise, the eastbound and westbound lanes 166
of United States route number twenty-two, between the 167
intersection of that route and Stubbs Mills road and the 168
intersection of that route and Zoar road, in Warren county, 169
shall be known as the "Lester and Mary Oeder Memorial Highway." 170

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 171
along the highway indicating its name. 172

Sec. 5534.921. In addition to any other name prescribed in 173
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 174
lanes of state route number seven between Washington boulevard 175
and Western reserve road, in Mahoning county, shall be known as 176
the "Clarence 'Sonny' Smith, Jr. Highway." 177

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 178
along the highway indicating its name. 179
