A BILL

To terminate the COVID-19 state of emergency in
Ohio and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Notwithstanding Chapter 5502. of the Revised
Code, the General Assembly hereby terminates the state of
emergency declared by Executive Order 2020-01D, issued on March
9, 2020.

Section 2. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is that
having a state of emergency for COVID-19 in effect for a
prolonged period of time, including when the reason for such
emergency no longer exists, harms the well-being of Ohio's
citizens and businesses. Therefore, this act shall go into
immediate effect.
