A BILL

To terminate certain provisions of the "Director's Order for Retail and Business Compliance for Facial Coverings throughout the State of Ohio," issued on November 13, 2020, and to declare an emergency. 1
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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. The General Assembly hereby terminates the paragraph labeled "10. Cooperation." of the "Director's Order for Retail and Business Compliance for Facial Coverings throughout the State of Ohio," issued on November 13, 2020. 6
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Section 2. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is that the portion of the November 13, 2020, "Director's Order for Retail and Business Compliance for Facial Coverings throughout the State of Ohio," which requires businesses to allow public health authorities and law enforcement officials to both access 10
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and inspect business premises during business hours, to provide 17
any information requested by such authorities and officials, and 18
to cooperate fully in any compliance inspection or 19
investigation, results in a severe burden on Ohio's businesses 20
and their employees. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate 21
effect. 22
