**A RESOLUTION**

Relative to the election of Cindy Abrams to fill the 1  
vacancy in the membership of the House of 2  
Representatives created by the resignation of Louis W. 3  
Blessing, III of the 29th House District. 4

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF  
OHIO:**

WHEREAS, Section 11 of Article II of the Ohio Constitution 5  
provides for the filling of a vacancy in the membership of the 6  
House of Representatives by election by the members of the House 7  
of Representatives who are affiliated with the same political 8  
party as the person last elected to the seat which has become 9  
vacant; and 10

WHEREAS, Louis W. Blessing, III of the 29th House District, 11  
has resigned as a member of the House of Representatives of the 12  
133rd General Assembly effective October 8, 2019, thus creating a 13  
vacancy in the House of Representatives; therefore be it 14

RESOLVED, By the members of the House of Representatives who 15  
are affiliated with the Republican party that Cindy Abrams, 16  
Republican, having the qualifications set forth in the Ohio 17  
Constitution and the laws of Ohio to be a member of the House of 18  
Representatives from the 29th House District, is hereby elected, 19  
effective October 10, 2019, pursuant to Section 11 of Article II 20  
of the Ohio Constitution, as a member of the House of 21  
Representatives from the 29th House District, to fill the vacancy 22  
created by the unexpired portion of the term of said Louis W. 23

Blessing, III, ending on December 31, 2020; and be it further	24
RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be spread upon the	25
pages of the Journal of the House of Representatives together with	26
the yeas and nays of the members of the House of Representatives	27
affiliated with the Republican party voting on the resolution, and	28
that the Clerk of the House of Representatives shall certify the	29
resolution and vote on its adoption to the Secretary of State.	30
