and it is imperative that we stress the danger facing our state's	9
residents so that they may curb and combat its harmful effects;	10

WHEREAS, With elevated levels of indoor radon gas present in	12
all of Ohio's eighty-eight counties, this problem is one that	13
faces the whole of our state, and it deserves our full attention.	14
