BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.078 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 5.078. Dunkleosteus terrelli, a species of extinct	6
arthrodire placoderm fish that lived in the seas that covered	
parts of Ohio during the Late Devonian period, about three	
nundred fifty-nine to three hundred eighty-two million years	
ago, is hereby adopted as the official fossil fish of the state.
