A BILL

To enact section 4141.34 of the Revised Code to 1
require the Director of Job and Family Services 2
to establish a process for employers to make 3
complaints regarding unemployment compensation 4
benefits. 5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4141.34 of the Revised Code be 6
enacted to read as follows: 7

Sec. 4141.34. The director of job and family services 8
shall establish and maintain a process for an employer to report 9
that an applicant for or recipient of benefits has failed or is 10
failing to meet any of the eligibility requirements described in 11
division (A) of section 4141.29 of the Revised Code. The process 12
shall allow an employer to make a complaint through a 13
conspicuous internet link located on the internet web site 14
maintained by the department of job and family services. The 15
director shall review all complaints received through this 16
process in a timely manner. 17
