and will be the first to rely heavily on online responses; and	10
WHEREAS, A complete and accurate count of Ohio's population	11
is essential; and	12
WHEREAS, Diverse communities and populations are at risk of	13
being missed in the 2020 decennial census; and	14
WHEREAS, The primary and perpetual challenge facing the	15
United States Census Bureau is an undercount; and	16
WHEREAS, The data collected by the decennial census	17
determines the number of seats each state has in the House of	18

challenges with the 2020 decennial census, including a	26
constrained fiscal environment, rapidly changing use of	27

WHEREAS, The General Assembly, in partnership with other	31
local governments, the state, businesses, schools, and community	32
organizations, is committed to robust outreach and communication	33
strategies focusing on reaching the hardest to count	34
