HOUSE COMMERCE AND LABOR COMMITTEE HOUSE BILL 146 - PROPONENT TESTIMONY

Chairman Stein and members of the committee.

Thank you for the opportunity to offer testimony as a proponent to Representative's Riedel and Manchester's House Bill 146.

I am here to testify on behalf of the County Engineer's Association of Ohio and as the Auglaize County Engineer. I just completed my 37th year as Auglaize County Engineer and was the County's Assistant County Engineer and Drainage Engineer nine years prior to that.

During my tenure, this department has let bids annually between \$1 million to \$2 million for roadway and bridge improvements and many years in excess of \$500,000 in petitioned ditch drainage improvements. Since becoming County Engineer this department has awarded bids to construct a bridge building and two salt storage facilities. All of these bids, based upon the current threshold limits were subject to Ohio's prevailing wage rates.

The Shelly Company has been awarded the bid for resurfacing in Auglaize County for 90%+ of the work for the past 20 years and was awarded the work for 2021. Attached is 2021 prevailing wage rate for 2021. Highlighted in yellow is the "Laborer Group 1" classification. The flag person for this year's resurfacing program in Auglaize County will receive, with benefits, \$ 40.66 per hour. The person driving the paving machine, Operator Class 2 shown on the second attachment, with benefits will receive \$53.57 per hour. My departments most experienced equipment operator, with 20+ years of experience and over 10,000 hours of time logged in that equipment, with benefits, will receive \$33.58 per hour or \$ 7.08 per hour less than the flag person on the paving program and \$20 per hour less than an operator performing similar work being paid prevailing wages.

On bridge replacement projects, the Professional Engineer on my staff that designed, drafted the plans and specifications along with inspecting the work for the structure is making the same or less than the laborers constructing that bridge.

At the Auglaize County Highway Department, in 1992 we installed fuel storage tanks and a computerized system that tracks 140,000 gallons of gasoline/diesel fuel to the nearest 0.1 a gallon. As a service to all county offices, we provide fuel to 14 agencies including the Sheriff, Emergency Management, Council on Aging and Veterans Services. By the fact we purchase our fuel in 8,000 gallon quantities, they have realized a sizeable savings. Now that the 30 year guarantee is about to expire on the tanks, we are anticipating replacing the system within the next few years. Attached is a quote from the company that currently

services our system. This company installs and services fuel dispensing systems for most of Ohio and surrounding states for both governmental agencies and private enterprises. The attachment shows on the first page the 2019 quote being \$309,975. The second page of that proposal, note item # 3 states that if the project is subject to prevailing wages, add \$36,000 to the quote. This tells me that firm has well qualified laborers to perform the work at the original quote but will be paid an additional \$36,000 if subject to prevailing wages.

On behalf of this department and Ohio's County Engineers, we ask this committee and the Ohio General Assembly support House Bill 146. The proposed higher threshold limits will free up dollars to construct another bridge, pave another mile or complete an additional safety improvement.

I wish to thank the committee for being able to testify in support of HB 146. I would be more than happy to answer any questions the committee may have.
