- Response Time
 - -Volunteer program
 - -Madison Local Schools have two SRO's/ substitute, sickness etc...
 - -SROs are targets/ Give teachers and students a fighting chance
 - -Teachers are to protect their classrooms and assignments. Last line of defense. NOT an offensive approach. Should not have to rely on staplers and baseball bats. They could legally protect their friends and families in a movie theater with their firearm, why not their students in a classroom.
 - -After school programs- concerts, plays, latch-key etc...
 - -Our sheriff department is in Hamilton, Ohio approximately 20 minutes away
 - -When does 911 get called?
- Training
 - -Proper training for school environment
 - -Oualification with law enforcement
 - -Identification
 - -Ongoing training
- Conclusion
 - -Top priority to keep students and staff safe
 - Allows local school districts to make the decision about what is best for their unique situations. Not one size fits all.
 - -H.B. 99 will add a layer of protection for the students and staff of Ohio
