Sponsor Testimony
House Bill 170
Before the House Committee on Finance

April 14, 2021

Chair Oelslager, Vice Chair Plummer, Ranking Member Crawley, and Members of the House Finance Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide sponsor testimony on House Bill 170, which will provide funding to assist schools and other entities as they continue to address and manage the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic.

To briefly summarize the provisions and impact of HB 170:

1. HB 170 re-appropriates unexpended, unencumbered funds from Fund 3HS0 and Fund 3HQ0 in FY 21 and FY 22 for FY 22 and FY 23.
2. HB 170 also re-appropriates unexpended, unencumbered funds from Fund 3HP0 in FY 21 and FY 22 for FY 22 and FY 23.

Further detail about how these funds are distributed is included in the table on the following page.
