My name is William Koltek. I am a 33-year Ohio resident, voter and taxpayer, and I am writing in opposition to House Bill 227. I live in a rural area (Louisville, OH). The Constitution of the United States of America is a great work of justice. The Ohio State Supreme Court has already ruled that "the right to bear arms is not absolute" and states have power of "regulation of the manner of carrying them", (State vs. Nieto, 1920).
