My name is Patricia Mroczka and I am a mother, a wife, and an accountant. The reason I support House Bill 248 is because I have the right to make medical decisions on my own and not be discriminated against. My body my choice. These vaccines are experimental drugs. We do not know the long term side effects. The vaccine was granted Emergency Use Authorization against Covid because there are no other treatments available, but there are other treatments available. We have various drugs that can be used to cure Covid.
