Dear Congressman Lipps,

I am submitting my testimony today in support of passage of HB248- Freedom from Vaccine. It is astonishing that this bill would even need to be considered because of the following reasons:

The vaccine is unapproved and experimental. The Nuremberg laws designate that NO ONE is to be enrolled in a scientific experiment against their will.

The vaccine does not guarantee that the person taking the vaccine will be immune to COVID19.
