

Written Testimony of Evan Little
Supports Sub HB 248
House Health Committee

Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Honorable Members of the House Health Committee,

Thank you for this opportunity to provide written testimony regarding Sub HB 248.

I am a PROPONENT of Sub HB 248 because I strongly believe in medical freedom of choice. I also strongly believe in a person's right to medical privacy and feel that it is not the business of the government, the school system, an employer, an insurance company, a retail store, or really anyone, what pharmaceutical product or vaccine one chooses or doesn't choose to consume.

One size does not fit all, meaning not every person is risk-free from vaccine reactions. The US Supreme Court has openly ruled that vaccines are "unavoidably unsafe." Product inserts which accompany most vaccines warn of dozens of potential side effects, including death. Every life matters, including those who are more susceptible to vaccine reactions. Every person is born with God-given, unalienable rights to make their own medical and healthcare choices.

I am opposed to vaccine mandates. I am opposed to all forms of discrimination and segregation, including vaccination discrimination. Vaccination passports go against privacy and should never be allowed, either.

Sub HB 248 is a vital step in ensuring every Ohioan has medical freedom of choice without the threat of discrimination, segregation, and denial of services, education, and employment. Ohioans should also be assured that their medical choices remain private.
