The School District Transfer Committee in Lindsey, Ohio circulated petitions to transfer Lindsey and part of Washington Township to the Gibsonburg school district. Once it was on the Sandusky County ballot, the Federal judge found House Bill 117 unconstitutional. It was too late to remove our initiative from the ballot, however, the votes cast were Yes 439-No 145.

Attached is data we provided to the community. We also placed yard signs and held public informational meetings. It is our hope that Bill 117 clears the House and Senate and becomes a law once more.

On Thursday, September 17th, our committee was informed by the Sandusky County Board of Elections that we can no longer continue our campaign.

Within the last week, a US District Court judge declared the School District Transfer Law (part of Ohio Revised Code 3311.242) to be unconstitutional because it was inappropriately attached to a school appropriation bill

Our November 3rd ballot will still include the transfer vote language, but we have been told by the Board of Elections that any yes or no vote on the issue will not be counted. At this time, we want the community at large to know the following about our campaign:

- All of our local processes were legal.
- All of our data was accurate
- . We did not know that this law would be declared unconstitutional
- · Both the September 27th (2:00 pm) and 29th (6:00 pm) public meetings will still be held at the Lindsey Park to provide any further discussion or answer any questions.
- . If you have a yard sign, it will be collected by a member of the committee within the next week. We hope to use them again in the future.
- We still want you to vote on November 3rd!

Finally, we THANK YOU for your support. The efforts from everyone who helped were not in vain. The support and encouragement we received to transfer our district to Gibsonburg was overwhelming and given the opportunity, we truly believe the measure would have greatly benefited our community.




