

HB90 Proponent Testimony
February 17, 2021

Chair Scott Wiggam, Vice Chair Marilyn John, Ranking Member Brigid Kelly and honorable members of the State and Local Government Committee. My name is Anthony DiBiase. I am a retired professional engineer and I am in support of HB90. I urge you to vote yes on HB90 so that there is reasonable oversight on any emergency lockdown of the entire State of Ohio as has been experienced beginning in 2020 and continuing in 2021. The lockdown all started with a “two-week time frame” to allow for the “flattening of the curve” for projected need of medical facilities attributed to the serious coronavirus illness/death prediction models including the **drastically erroneous** Neil Ferguson model. That lockdown action included the sole Governor/Health Department designation of essential and non-essential jobs and businesses associated with the lockdown.
