Re: Amendment to HB 203

Thank you for the opportunity to express the Ohio Veterinary Medical Licensing Board's support of Amendment No. AM_134_1407 to HB 203, sponsored by Representative Jena Powell. The OVMLB shared its concerns with Representative Powell regarding specific language that would have prevented an Ohio resident from obtaining a Limited or Provisional Veterinary License.

The OVMLB is appreciative of Rep. Powell's willingness to listen and act on the Board's concerns. This amendment, as submitted, will permit Ohio veterinary graduates to obtain the Limited License which permits a veterinarian to specialize in a certain area of practice in a residency program and will permit the ability to obtain a Provisional License which allows a graduate veterinarian who has not achieved a passing score on the national examination to practice as a veterinarian under the supervision of a licensed veterinarian.
