

Proponent Testimony for House Bill 165 Ohio House Ways and Means Committee March 23, 2021

Members of the Ohio House Ways & Means Committee,

On behalf of Sheetz, I write in support of House Bill 165. This legislation will institute a non-refundable, temporary tax credit for fuel retailers selling E15 and E85 fuel; increasing access to higher ethanol blends for consumers and benefiting the community.

Sheetz is a family-owned convenience store chain which operates over 600 stores in 6 states. Currently, we have 43 stores in Ohio, primarily in the Northeast Ohio; and will open our first central Ohio location in early April.

As a family-owned and operated brand, Sheetz is dedicated to supporting the community and our consumers. We were one of the first and largest adopters of E15 in Ohio and across the country. We know that E15 is a high-performance fuel that increases horsepower while burning cleaner and cooler than regular gasoline. It also reduces harmful emissions and contains fewer toxic additives while decreasing the need for foreign oil and supporting agriculture.

Our company has numerous locations in multiple states where we offer consumers additional choices through E15 and E85 pumps. Offering a tax credit in Ohio will undoubtedly encourage the fuel retail industry to look at Ohio as a first option.
