

PROPONENT TESTIMONY

Chairman McColley, Vice Chair Schuring, Ranking Member Williams, and members of the committee. My name is Pamela J. Doty and I reside in Union Township, Auglaize County. I am here in support of SB 52 and will give reasons why we support this bill.

On February 12, 2021 I become aware of a proposed project by Moonwalk Energy¹ in Auglaize County. The proposed project affects Clay, Goshen, Wayne, and Union Township. This proposed Wind and Solar project is up to 200-300 MV Wind capacity including 50-100 Wind Turbines and a Solar Facility up to 100 MV. The four townships have a combined population of 5,182 from the 2019 Census² and have a combined total of 111.1 square miles³ in the townships. That is 46.46 people per square mile that this project affects. I have lived in Goshen Township for 20 years and Union for 40 years.

After speaking with several neighbors, friends, and family we realized so many others in the community we unaware as well. The larger landowners were notified in November 2020 if not before. Since then in talking to landowners that signed, they were not aware this is a hybrid project. We created a community group Auglaize Township United to spread awareness and educate ourselves on the process of these proposed projects. We learned that the lack of input from the townships to decide what is best for the community as a whole is non existent. A handful of landowners will be deciding what is best for the whole community. I don't believe that is fair that a small amount of landowners should decide for everyone.

Township Trustees have their finger on the pulse of their constituents and know what best works for their Townships. I believe local Townships should have the right to decide if this is the best fit for the community. I do not think that the Ohio Power Siting Board should bypass the Townships and the County. Senate Bill 52 is a very fair bill that will give local control back.

Our homes are in a residential/agricultural rural setting and we bought our homes for that very reason. Our property values will decrease due to the proposed project converting the community into more of an industrial area. I am very concerned about our quality of life being affected in such close proximity to Wind/ Solar Fields. Sun flicker and noise from these projects is a major concern.

In closing I want to Thank you for allowing my testimony and I fully support SB 52. I encourage you too as well.
