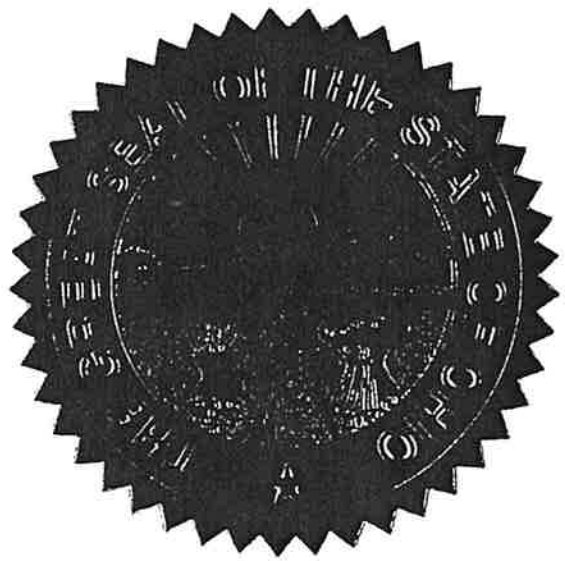

Gregory New graduated from Stark State Technical College with an Associate Degree in Engineering Design, then went on to obtain a Bachelor of Science Degree in Petroleum Engineering from Marietta College in Marietta, Ohio.

New started his career working for an oil and gas producer/service company, pumping wells, while in high school and college. After graduation from Marietta, he started working for Witco Chemical Corp owners of the Kendall Oil Refinery in Bradford Pa. as a production/ drilling engineer.

During the drilling boom in Ohio from 1980 to 1994 he worked for Petrocon Inc. in East Canton Ohio as VP of the company supervising the drilling, completion and production of all oil and gas wells for Petrocon and Dorfman Production Co. During that time, he drilled more than 175 successful wells. In 1994 he went to work directly for Dorfman Production Co. a Texas Corporation as VP supervising all aspects of the leasing, drilling, completion and production of over 125 additional new wells in Ohio and Texas. Dorfman currently still operates all of these wells. In 2018 New purchased Louis Dorfman's interest in the company and is now one of the owners.

New has personally supervised the drilling and completion of over 400 wells in NE Ohio. He has been working in the industry for over 45 years and has been a member of the International Society of Petroleum Engineers for 46 years. He also has been a member of the Ohio Oil and Gas Association for the past 42 years and serves on the Producers Committee. In 2011, the Governor of Ohio appointed New to the Technical Advisory Council on Oil and Gas for the Ohio Department of Natural Resources. In 2017, he was made chairman of that commission. He is President of Brineaway Inc. a production water disposal business operating in two counties in Ohio. He is also President of the Board of Directors of Copeland Oaks and Crandell Medical Center located in Sebring, Ohio.

He was born April 14, 1955 in Canton, Ohio and is a graduate of Glenwood High School where he met his lovely wife. He has been happily married for the past 46 years and has 3 wonderful daughters, son in laws and 2 grandchildren with 2 more on the way.
