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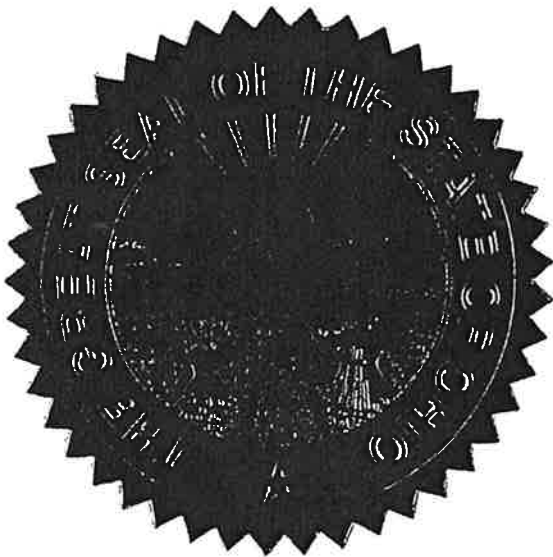

Under his leadership, People Working Cooperatively (PWC) has earned the Better Business Bureau's Wise Giving Seal of Charitable Accountability, was named as the 2009 Non Profit of the Year by the Cincinnati Chamber of Commerce, and received the 2016 Torch Award for Marketplace Ethics from the Cincinnati Better Business Bureau (BBB). PWC has grown from providing 2,000 total services in 1987 to averaging 9,000 services every year, serving 18 counties in Ohio, Kentucky and Indiana.

In February 2019 PWC successfully launched the PWC Whole Home Innovation Center, a first-of-its kind space focused on the relationship of our homes and our health. The Innovation Center offers the unique opportunity for hands on learning experience, interactive learning and discussion workshops/classes, as well as opportunities for partnerships/collaborations. Part think tank, part demonstration center, Innovation Center will serve the entire community.
