**A BILL**

To enact section 5.246 of the Revised Code to 1  
designate March 29 as "Ohio Tuskegee Airmen 2  
Day." 3

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 5.246 of the Revised Code be 4  
enacted to read as follows: 5

**Sec. 5.246.** The twenty-ninth day of March is designated as 6  
"Ohio Tuskegee Airmen Day." 7
