BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3901.80 of the Revised Code be	7
enacted to read as follows:	8
Sec. 3901.80. (A) As used in this section:	9
(1) "Living organ donor" means a living person who donates	10
an organ to another living person.	11

<u>(2) "Policy of insurance" means a life insurance policy,</u>	12
disability insurance policy, or long-term care insurance policy.	13
(B) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,	14
an insurer shall not unfairly discriminate against a living	15
organ donor in the offering, issuance, premium, or conditions of	16
a policy of insurance based solely, and without any additional	17
actuarial risks, on that person's status as a living organ	18
donor.	19
(C) A violation of division (B) of this section shall be	20
considered an unfair and deceptive practice in the business of	21
insurance under section 3901.21 of the Revised Code.	22
(D) The superintendent of insurance may adopt rules as	23
necessary to carry out the requirements of this section.	24
Section 2. Notwithstanding any provision of Title XXXV of	25

primary election and any special election held on the day of the

(A) Uniformed services and overseas absent voter's ballots	29
shall be printed and ready for use not later than the first day	30
