A BILL

То	halt the collection of all debt owed to any	1

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Beginning on the effective date of this section	8
and during any remaining period of the emergency declared by	
Executive Order 2020-01D, issued on March 9, 2020, and	
notwithstanding any contrary provision of the Revised Code:	
(A) The state, or its agencies or political subdivisions,	12
shall not commence collection proceedings against any individual	
or entity that owes any amount to any state institution of	14
higher education or a hospital operated by a state institution	

of higher education for that amount owed;

(B) No interest shall accrue on any debt owed to any state	17	
institution of higher education or a hospital operated by a		
state institution of higher education;	19	
(C) The state, and its agencies and political	20	
subdivisions, shall not collect any fees related to any	21	
outstanding debts owed to any state institution of higher	22	
education or a hospital operated by a state institution of	23

(D) Sections 131.02 to 131.03 of the Revised Code are	25	
suspended to the extent those sections require collections to be	26	
made against individuals or entities owing any amount to any		
state institution of higher education or a hospital operated by	28

As used in this section, "state institution of higher	30	
education" has the meaning defined in section 3345.011 of the		
Revised Code.		
Section 2. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency	33	
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	34	
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is that	35	
the COVID-19 epidemic is putting unprecedented strain on Ohio's	36	
economy, and halting state debt collections against individuals	37	
owing money to state institutions of higher education or	38	
hospitals operated by those institutions will provide economic	39	
relief to the citizens of Ohio. Therefore, this act shall go	40	
into immediate effect.	41
