electric services through an electric distribution utility as	8
defined in section 4928.01 of the Revised Code for a structure	9
on the customer's property that is separately metered from the	10
customer's primary residence shall be charged at the same rate	11
as the primary residence for electric service.	12
(B) Division (A) of this section does not apply for a	13
structure used for commercial activity.	14
Sec. 4933.501. The public utilities commission shall adopt	15
rules for the implementation of section 4933.50 of the Revised	16
