"Section 1. That section 3319.60 of the Revised Code be 6
amended to read as follows: 7

Sec. 3319.60. There is hereby established the educator 8
standards board. The board shall develop and recommend to the 9
state board of education standards for entering and continuing 10
in the educator professions and standards for educator 11
professional development. The board membership shall reflect the 12
diversity of the state in terms of gender, race, ethnic 13
background, and geographic distribution. 14

(A) The board shall consist of the following members: 15

(1) The following nineteen members appointed by the state 16
board of education: 17

(a) Ten persons employed as teachers in a school district. 18
Three persons appointed under this division shall be employed as 19
teachers in a secondary school, two persons shall be employed as 20
teachers in a middle school, three persons shall be employed as 21

teachers in an elementary school, one person shall be employed 22
as a teacher in a pre-kindergarten classroom, and one person 23
shall be a teacher who serves on a local professional 24
development committee pursuant to section 3319.22 of the Revised 25
Code. At least one person appointed under this division shall 26
hold a teaching certificate or license issued by the national 27
board for professional teaching standards. The Ohio education 28
association shall submit a list of fourteen nominees for these 29
appointments and the state board may appoint up to seven members 30
to the educator standards board from that list. The Ohio 31
federation of teachers shall submit a list of six nominees for 32
these appointments and the state board may appoint up to three 33
members to the educator standards board from that list. If there 34
is an insufficient number of nominees from both lists to satisfy 35
the membership requirements of this division, the state board 36
shall request additional nominees who satisfy those 37
requirements. 38

(b) One person employed as a teacher in a chartered, 39
nonpublic school. Stakeholder groups selected by the state board 40
shall submit a list of two nominees for this appointment. 41

(c) Five persons employed as school administrators in a 42
school district. Of those five persons, one person shall be 43
employed as a secondary school principal, one person shall be 44
employed as a middle school principal, one person shall be 45
employed as an elementary school principal, one person shall be 46
employed as a school district treasurer or business manager, and 47
one person shall be employed as a school district 48
superintendent. The buckeye association of school administrators 49
shall submit a list of two nominees for the school district 50
superintendent, the Ohio association of school business 51
officials shall submit a list of two nominees for the school 52

district treasurer or business manager, the Ohio association of 53
elementary school administrators shall submit a list of two 54
nominees for the elementary school principal, and the Ohio 55
association of secondary school administrators shall submit a 56
list of two nominees for the middle school principal and a list 57
of two nominees for the secondary school principal. 58

(d) One person who is a member of a school district board 59
of education. The Ohio school boards association shall submit a 60
list of two nominees for this appointment. 61

(e) One person who is a parent of a student currently 62
enrolled in a school operated by a school district. The Ohio 63
parent teacher association shall submit a list of two nominees 64
for this appointment. 65

(f) One person who represents community schools 66
established under Chapter 3314. of the Revised Code. 67

(2) The chancellor of ~~the Ohio board of regents~~ higher 68
education shall appoint three persons employed by institutions 69
of higher education that offer educator preparation programs. 70
One person shall be employed by an institution of higher 71
education that has a certificate of authorization under Chapter 72
1713. of the Revised Code; one person shall be employed by a 73
state university, as defined in section 3345.011 of the Revised 74
Code, or a university branch; and one person shall be employed 75
by a state community college, community college, or technical 76
college. Of the two persons appointed from an institution of 77
higher education that has a certificate of authorization under 78
Chapter 1713. of the Revised Code and from a state university or 79
university branch, ~~one shall be employed in a college of~~ 80
~~education and one shall be employed in a college of arts and~~ 81
~~sciences.:~~ 82

(a) One shall be a representative of the Ohio association 83
of private colleges for teacher education, or its successor 84
organization. 85

(b) One shall be a representative of the state university 86
education deans of Ohio, or its successor organization. 87

The chancellor shall appoint a representative from each of 88
the organizations specified in divisions (A) (2) (a) and (b) of 89
this section not later than sixty days after the effective date 90
of this amendment. Each representative shall serve a two-year 91
term beginning July 1, 2023. 92

(3) The speaker of the house of representatives shall 93
appoint two persons who are active in or retired from the 94
education profession. 95

(4) The president of the senate shall appoint two persons 96
who are active in or retired from the education profession. 97

(5) The superintendent of public instruction or a designee 98
of the superintendent, the chancellor of ~~the Ohio board of~~ 99
~~regents higher education~~ or a designee of the chancellor, and 100
the chairpersons and the ranking minority members of the 101
education committees of the senate and house of representatives 102
shall serve as nonvoting, ex officio members. 103

(B) Terms of office shall be for two years. Each member 104
shall hold office from the date of the member's appointment 105
until the end of the term for which the member was appointed. At 106
the first meeting, appointed members shall select a chairperson 107
and a vice-chairperson. Vacancies on the board shall be filled 108
in the same manner as prescribed for appointments under division 109
(A) of this section. Any member appointed to fill a vacancy 110
occurring prior to the expiration of the term for which the 111

member's predecessor was appointed shall hold office for the 112
remainder of such term. Any member shall continue in office 113
subsequent to the expiration date of the member's term until the 114
member's successor takes office, or until a period of sixty days 115
has elapsed, whichever occurs first. The terms of office of 116
members are renewable. 117

(C) Members shall receive no compensation for their 118
services. 119

(D) The board shall establish guidelines for its 120
operation. These guidelines ~~shall require the creation of a~~ 121
~~standing subcommittee on higher education, and shall~~ permit the 122
creation of ~~other~~ standing subcommittees when necessary. The 123
board shall determine the membership of any subcommittee it 124
creates. The board may select persons who are not members of the 125
board to participate in the deliberations of any subcommittee as 126
representatives of stakeholder groups, but no such person shall 127
vote on any issue before the subcommittee. 128

Section 2. That existing section 3319.60 of the Revised 129
Code is hereby repealed." 130
