BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3365.131 and 3365.132 of the				
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:				
Sec. 3365.131. (A) The Ohio STEM gateway program is hereby	9			
established under the college credit plus program.				
(1) Under the gateway program, each public secondary	11			
school shall enter into an agreement with at least one public				
college and jointly develop thirty-credit hour pathways in				
science, technology, engineering, mathematics, and health care				
fields. Schools may use existing pathways developed under				
section 3365.13 of the Revised Code for the purposes of this				
section.	17			

(2) Each college shall award a one-year technical				
certificate in the appropriate field of study to each student				
who completes a pathway developed under division (A)(1) of this				
section.	21			
(B)(1) The Ohio STEM retention program is hereby	22			
established. Under the retention program, each student who	23			
completes a pathway developed under division (A) of this section				
and subsequently enrolls in a public college in a science,	25			
technology, engineering, mathematics, or health care associate's	26			
or baccalaureate degree program or certification program	27			
approved by the chancellor of higher education shall be eligible	28			
for an annual tuition waiver of two thousand dollars for up to	29			
three academic years.	30			
(2) Each public college that enrolls a student to which	31			
division (B)(1) of this section applies shall report to the	32			
chancellor, by the first day of July of each year, the number of	33			
students who were so enrolled during the preceding year. The	34			
chancellor shall then calculate the total amount for and provide				
a grant to each college for that amount.				
(C) The chancellor shall adopt rules to administer the	37			
program established under division (B) of this section.				
Sec. 3365.132. (A) The Ohio IT promise program is hereby	39			
established. Under the program, an individual is eligible for up	40			
to four thousand dollars in student loan forgiveness if the				
individual satisfies all of the following:	42			
(1) Participates in the Ohio STEM retention program under	43			
section 3365.131 of the Revised Code;				
(2) Graduates with a certificate approved by the	45			
chancellor of higher education, associate's degree, or				

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baccalaureate degree in a science, technology, engineering,			
mathematics, or health care field;			
(3) Maintains continuous residence in this state for five	49		
years after graduating.			
(B) The chancellor shall adopt rules to administer the	51		
Ohio IT promise program.			
Section 2. All items in this act are hereby appropriated	53		
as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the	54		
credit of the designated fund. For all operating appropriations	55		
made in this act, those in the first column are for fiscal year			
2022 and those in the second column are for fiscal year 2023.			
The operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to			
any other operating appropriations made for the FY 2022-FY 2023			
biennium.

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OHIO STEM RETENTION PROGRAM

The foregoing appropriation item 2356A1, Ohio STEM64Retention Program, shall be used by the Chancellor of Higher65Education to reimburse public colleges, as defined in section663365.01 of the Revised Code, pursuant to section 3365.131 of the67Revised Code.68

An amount equal to the unexpended, unencumbered balance of the foregoing appropriation item 2356A1, Ohio STEM Retention Program, at the end of fiscal year 2022 is hereby reappropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2023.

OHIO IT PROMISE

The foregoing appropriation item 2356A2, Ohio IT Promise, shall be used by the Chancellor of Higher Education pursuant to section 3365.132 of the Revised Code.

An amount equal to the unexpended, unencumbered balance of the foregoing appropriation item 2356A2, Ohio IT Promise, at the end of fiscal year 2022 is hereby reappropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2023.

Section 4. Within the limits set forth in this act, the 81 Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 82 indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 83 made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 84 which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 85 from operating appropriations contained in this act shall be 86 accounted for as though made in H.B. 110 of the 134th General 87 Assembly. The operating appropriations made in this act are 88 subject to all provisions of H.B. 110 of the 134th General 89 Assembly that are generally applicable to such appropriations. 90

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
