BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3321.042 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 3321.042. As used in this section, "mental health	7
day" describes a school day during which a student attends to	8
the student's emotional and psychological well-being in lieu of	9
attending school.	10
Notwithstanding division (A)(1) of section 3321.04 of the	11
Revised Code, school districts may permit a student in grades	12
kindergarten to twelve to take up to three mental health days as	13
excused absences from school. If a school district permits a	14
student's absence under this section, the absence shall be	15
excused without the need for a physician's or other health	16
professional's certification of the student's condition, and the	17

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district shall give the student the opportunity to make up any school work missed during the absence. Any mental health day excused under this section shall not be considered in determining absence hours for the purposes of parental notice under division (C) (1) of section 3321.191 of the Revised Code.
