A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To recommend that the Air Force Research Lab at Wright 1
Patterson Air Force Base containing the anechoic 2
chamber be designated the Colonel William J. Cavanaugh 3
Battlefield Acoustics Lab. 4

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):**

WHEREAS, The American Institute of Physics has published 5
Colonel William J. Cavanaugh's oral history in which he explains 6
the groundbreaking architectural achievement known as the 7
anechoic chamber in Ohio nearly seven decades ago; and 8

WHEREAS, The National Veterans Memorial and Museum has a 9
bench dedicated to Colonel and Mrs. Cavanaugh located in the 10
Memorial Grove; and 11

WHEREAS, The National Museum of the United States Air Force 12
in Dayton has added Colonel Cavanaugh to its "Wall of Honor" 13
alongside his beloved wife and son; and 14

WHEREAS, The Technical Committee on Architectural Acoustics 15
of the Acoustical Society of America has voted to endorse this 16
naming effort; now therefore be it 17

RESOLVED, That the 134th General Assembly of the State of 18
Ohio supports designating the Air Force Research Lab containing 19
the anechoic chamber at Wright Patterson Air Force Base the 20
Colonel William J. Cavanaugh United States Air Force Battlefield 21
Acoustics Lab in recognition of his outstanding and enduring 22
service to our nation; and be it further 23
