A RESOLUTION

Observing April 2021 as the Month of the Military Child in Ohio.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 134th General 1 Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize the Month of the Military Child in Ohio, April 2021; and 3 WHEREAS, In an effort to increase public knowledge and understanding of the issues 4 surrounding children who have a parent in the military, the month of April was first designated 5 by then U.S. Secretary of Defense Caspar Weinberger as the Month of the Military Child in 6 1986.
