**A BILL**

To enact section 3792.02 of the Revised Code to  
prohibit certain mandatory vaccinations and  
other activities related to an individual's  
vaccination status and to make an appropriation  
related to coronavirus local fiscal recovery.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 3792.02 of the Revised Code be  
enacted to read as follows:

**Sec. 3792.02.** (A) To the extent permitted by federal law  
and notwithstanding any conflicting provision of the Revised  
Code, a private or public entity shall not do either or both of  
the following:

(1) Require an individual to receive a vaccine for which  
the United States food and drug administration has not granted  
full approval;

(2) Require an individual who has not received a vaccine described in division (A) (1) of this section to engage in or refrain from engaging in activities or precautions that differ from the activities or precautions of an individual who has elected to receive such a vaccine.

(B) Divisions (A) (1) and (2) of this section do not apply with respect to a private residence.

**Section 2.** All items in this act are hereby appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all operating appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are for fiscal year 2022 and those in the second column are for fiscal year 2023. The operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to any other operating appropriations made for the FY 2022-FY 2023 biennium.
