BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A)(1) There is hereby established a committee, 4 in recognition of the 400th anniversary of African Americans in 5 Ohio and the United States, to study the progress and challenges 6 of African Americans in Ohio. The committee shall review various 7 reports on African Americans in Ohio, including the Report of 8 the Ohio Commission on Racial Fairness, the Governor's Task 9 Force Report on Black and Minority Health, and any reports 10 prepared by public or private research institutions in Ohio that 11 the committee determines are relevant. 12

(2) After reviewing the reports specified under division
(A) (1) of this section, the committee shall prepare an initial
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report of all of the following:
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(a) The progress or lack of progress of African Americans
in Ohio with respect to housing, transportation, health,
education, employment, environment, business development, and
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(b) The contributions and achievements by African 20 Americans in Ohio; 21 (c) Recommendations for addressing the challenges 22 identified under division (A)(2) of this section for African 23 Americans in Ohio. 24 Not later than December 31, 2021, the committee shall 25 submit its initial report to the General Assembly in accordance 26 with section 101.68 of the Revised Code and to the news media of 27 Ohio. The committee shall include with the report an 28 29 announcement of the schedule of hearings it will hold on the report in accordance with division (A) (3) of this section. 30 (3) Not earlier than three months after submitting its 31 initial report under division (A)(2) of this section, the 32 committee shall reconvene for the purpose of holding hearings in 33 various parts of the state regarding its initial report. The 34 committee shall determine how many hearings to hold, the 35 schedule for these hearings, and the locations in which these 36 hearings will be held. These hearings shall be held over a 37 period of time that does not exceed four months. 38 The committee shall announce the schedule of the hearings 39 at the time it releases its initial report under division (A)(2) 40 of this section. 41 (4) Following the completion of the hearings held by the 42 committee under division (A) (3) of this section, the committee 43 shall revise its initial report based on the information 44 gathered during the hearings. Not later than October 31, 2022, 45 the committee shall submit its final report to the General 46 Assembly in accordance with section 101.68 of the Revised Code 47

any other policy area that the committee chooses to consider;

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and to the news media of Ohio. Upon submission of the final48report under division (A)(4) of this section, the committee49shall be abolished.50

(B) (1) The committee shall consist of ten members
appointed by the Governor, five members appointed by the
President of the Senate, five members appointed by the Minority
Leader of the Senate, five members appointed by the Speaker of
the House of Representatives, and five members appointed by the
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Minority Leader of the House of Representatives. The appointed
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members shall be representatives of all of the following:

(a) The Ohio History Connection;

(b) The National Museum of Afro-American History and Culture;

(c) Public and private research institutions in Ohio, including the John Glenn College of Public Affairs at the Ohio State University, the Kirwan Institution for the Study of Race and Ethnicity at the Ohio State University, Case Western Reserve University, Cleveland State University, and the Health Policy Institute of Ohio;

(d) The Ohio Civil Rights Commission.

(2) Not later than thirty days after the effective date of this section, the committee shall hold its first meeting and select a chairperson and vice-chairperson.

(3) The committee may, in its discretion, establish
subcommittees and designate members of the committee to serve on
those subcommittees. Each subcommittee may, in its discretion,
add members to the subcommittee that are not members of the
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committee appointed under division (B) (1) of this section.

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69 70 (4) The committee shall select, through an application process, a research institute to provide staff support to the committee.

(5) Committee members shall be reimbursed for actual and79necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.80

Section 2. All items in this section are hereby 81 appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state 82 treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all 83 appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are 84 for fiscal year 2020 and those in the second column are for 85 fiscal year 2021. The appropriations made in this act are in 86 addition to any other appropriations made for the FY 2020-FY 87 2021 biennium. 88

The amount appropriated by this act to the foregoing92appropriation item 360509, Outreach and Partnership, in fiscal93

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year 2021 shall be used to pay the expenses of the committee to 94 study the progress and challenges of African Americans in Ohio 95 in carrying out its functions established in Section 1 of this 96 act. An amount equal to the unexpended, unencumbered portion of 97 the foregoing appropriated amount at the end of fiscal year 2021 98 is hereby reappropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 99 2022. 100

Section 4. Within the limits set forth in this act, the 101 Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 102 indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 103 made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 104 which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 105 from operating appropriations contained in this act shall be 106 accounted for as though made in the main operating 107 appropriations act of the 133rd General Assembly. The operating 108 appropriations made in this act are subject to all provisions of 109 the main operating appropriations act of the 133rd General 110 Assembly that are generally applicable to such appropriations. 111

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
