State Track and Field Champion.

Seated Division State Championship in the 400- and 800-meter races;

WHEREAS, A junior at Elmwood High School, Jaydon Jenkins has

athlete. With admirable dedication, he has worked diligently toward

secured first place in the 400- and 800-meter races with times of
