WHEREAS, The United States Secretary of Defense, with the endorsement of President Biden, is requiring members of the armed forces to submit to a COVID-19 vaccination that is fully 7 approved by the Food and Drug Administration; and 8 WHEREAS, The United States Air Force is requiring active 9 duty members to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by November 10 2, 2021; and 11 WHEREAS, The United States Navy is requiring all members to 12 be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by November 28, 2021, and 13 all Navy Reserve members by December 28, 2021; and 14 WHEREAS, The United States Marine Corps is requiring all 15 active-duty members to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by 16 November 28, 2021, and all reservists by December 28, 2021; and 17 WHEREAS, The United States Air Force National Guard and Air 18 Force Reserve are requiring members to be fully vaccinated 19 against COVID-19 by December 2, 2021; and 20

No. 204 As Reported by the Senate General Government Budget Committee WHEREAS, The United States Army is requiring all active-21 duty members to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by December 22 15, 2021, and all National Guard members by June 30, 2022; and 23 WHEREAS, The United States Army released a statement 24 detailing that soldiers who refuse to submit to a COVID-19 25 vaccination "will first be counseled by their chain of command 26 and medical providers" and "continued failure to comply could 27 result in administrative or non-judicial punishment - to include 28 relief of duties or discharge"; and 29 WHEREAS, The United States Army has further stated, 30 "Commanders, command sergeants major, first sergeants and 31 officers in Command Select List...positions who refuse to be 32 vaccinated - and are not pending an exemption request - face 33 suspension and relief if they refuse to comply"; and 34 WHEREAS, The United States Army has further stated, 35 "Officers and noncommissioned officers who have been selected 36 and are waiting to assume [Command Select List] command, key 37 billet or nominative sergeant major positions...will likewise be 38 subject to removal from the list for those assignments should 39 they refuse to be vaccinated without a pending or approved 40 exemption"; and 41 WHEREAS, Such reprimands can be career-ending, according to 42 the United States Army; now therefore be it 43 RESOLVED, That we, the members of the Ohio Senate of the 44 134th General Assembly, urge the President not to allow members 45 of the United States Armed Forces to be punished or reprimanded 46 in any way, including discharge, for refusing to submit to a 47 COVID-19 vaccination; and be it further 48 RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Ohio Senate transmit duly 49 authenticated copies of this resolution to the President of the 50 United States, the United States Secretary of Defense, all 51
