A RESOLUTION

Honoring Lawrence Terkel on securing four medals at the 2022
National Senior Olympic Games

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 134th General Assembly of
Ohio are pleased to extend special recognition to Lawrence Terkel on
his tremendous success at the 2022 National Senior Olympic Games; and

WHEREAS, Lawrence Terkel is deserving of commendation for the
remarkable athletic gifts and indomitable spirit that he has so amply
displayed as a participant in the National Senior Olympic Games. A
tenacious swimmer, he excelled in the 75-79 age group, decisively
winning gold medals and setting records in the 50-yard freestyle race
with a time of 27.23 and the 100-yard freestyle race with a time of
1:03.42. In addition, he won a silver medal in the 50-yard butterfly
and a bronze medal in the 100-yard breaststroke, and his exceptional
prowess has made his family and friends very proud; and

WHEREAS, A tenacious competitor, Lawrence Terkel can always be
counted on to shine, and understandably, the strength, agility,
stamina, and skill that he has exhibited have earned him many
admirers. Clearly, his enthusiastic involvement in swimming has
