ODH duties regarding SUDEP information 20

R.C. 3701.1311 21

Removes a requirement that information about sudden 22
 unexpected death in epilepsy (SUDEP) provided by a health care 23
 practitioner must come from the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) 24
 and instead requires SUDEP information to come from the federal 25
 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). 26

Removes a requirement that ODH provide health care 27
 practitioners with written information about SUDEP and post 28
 SUDEP information on the ODH website; instead requires ODH to 29
 post a link to the CDC SUDEP information page on ODH's website. 30

Related to those changes, removes requirements that (1) 31
 SUDEP information be reviewed and approved by professional 32
 nonprofit organizations with expertise in neurology and epilepsy 33
 and (2) the ODH Director ensure SUDEP information provided is 34
 culturally and linguistically appropriate. 35

Removes a requirement that the ODH Director provide 36
 guidance to health care practitioners in order to assist them in 37
 determining whether a patient has an elevated risk for SUDEP. 38

Removes possible penalties for violations of the section	39
and the requirement that the ODH Director warn health care	40
practitioners of an initial violation.	41
