**Federal educational financial assistance programs**

**R.C. 3333.46**

Requires the Chancellor to award scholarships under the  
Armed Forces Reserve Component Scholarship Program to an  
applicant only after money from federal educational financial  
assistance programs, for which the applicant is eligible based  
on the applicant's military service, has already been applied to  
the applicant's eligible expenses.

The Chancellor may, but does not have to, require  
applicants to apply for federal aid for which they qualify as a  
result of military service. Any aid that an applicant receives  
through such programs must be applied to the applicant's  
eligible expenses first, before money from the Armed Forces  
Reserve Component Scholarship Program is applied. The As  
Introduced version of the bill left this to the Chancellor's  
discretion.

**Armed Forces Reserve Component Scholarship Program -  
eligibility requirements**

Lowers the number of eligibility units a scholarship  
recipient may earn through the Armed Forces Reserve Component  
Scholarship Program from 96 to 48. These eligibility units may  
be earned at any point during a scholarship recipient's post-  
secondary education and need not be consecutive.

Requires that a scholarship recipient be enrolled as a  
full-time student to be eligible for the Armed Forces Reserve  
Component Scholarship Program. The recipient need not

necessarily be enrolled full-time for the entirety of their 66  
studies, but rather must be enrolled full-time during any 67  
semester or quarter for which the recipient receives money from 68  
the Program. 69

**S.B. 9 exemption 70**

**R.C. 3333.46 71**

Exempts the Chancellor from the requirements set forth in 72  
S.B. 9 of the 134th General Assembly, which requires certain 73  
entities to eliminate two administrative rules for each 74  
administrative rule they adopt that contains a regulatory 75  
restriction. 76
