_____ moved to amend the amendment labeled AM1281-2 as follows:

In line 214 of the amendment, delete the underlined semicolon and insert ". If the record is retained, it becomes a public record on the day that is three years after the day on which the record was created."

In line 1011 of the amendment, after "service" insert ", or a former designated public service worker who was an elected official, regardless of length of service"

In line 1027 of the amendment, after "standing" insert ". A qualifying former designated public service worker, who was an elected official, shall provide, with the form, a certificate of oath. A judge, in lieu of a certificate of oath, may provide a letter, confirming service, from the Ohio judicial conference or the supreme court"

In line 1062 of the amendment, after "standing" insert ". A qualifying former designated public service worker, who was an elected official, shall provide, with the form, a certificate of oath. A judge, in lieu of a certificate of oath, may provide a letter, confirming service, from the Ohio judicial conference or the supreme court"
