**Department of Public Safety inspection authority** 19

**R.C. 4737.04 and 4737.046** 20

Broadens the Department of Public Safety's authority to 21  
investigate and search the premises of scrap metal dealers, bulk 22  
merchandise container dealers, and other persons that sell or 23  
receive used catalytic converters. 24

The bill allows such investigations only when the director 25  
(1) receives a written complaint supported by evidence, and (2) 26  
determines that a prima facie case exists that the person is 27  
violating the bill. The amendment eliminates these 28  
prerequisites. 29
