7 SYNOPSIS

8 **Community school sponsor ratings**

9 **R.C. 3314.016 and Section 733.90**

10 Removes provisions of the Senate-passed version of the bill  
11 that do the following:

12 - Excludes the academic performance of a community school  
13 most recently sponsored by the Office of School Sponsorship from  
14 the sponsor performance rating, for the first two years of  
15 sponsorship, of a sponsor rated exemplary on its three most  
16 recent evaluations.

17 - Requires the Department of Education and Workforce (DEW)  
18 to use the higher of the academic performance score as  
19 determined by weighting each school based on enrollment or by  
20 weighting each school equally.

21 - Requires each community school sponsor to submit  
22 documentation of adherence to quality practices by May 15 of  
23 each year and permits the sponsor to participate in an interview  
24 to assess those practices.

25 - Makes all exemplary-rated sponsors eligible for statutory  
26 incentives, rather than only sponsors rated exemplary for the  
27 two most recent school years.

28 - Requires DEW to post the 2023-2024 evaluation system on  
29 its website by October 1, 2023, notwithstanding the current law  
30 requirement to post the system on its website by the February 1  
31 prior to the school year for which the system will be used.

32 - Requires DEW to evaluate a sponsor for the 2024-2025  
33 school year if the sponsor received an overall rating of  
34 ineffective on its most recent evaluation or the sponsor is a  
35 new sponsor that has not been previously evaluated but permits  
36 any other sponsor to choose to be evaluated for that school  
37 year.

38 - Requires DEW, by November 15, 2023, to issue a request  
39 for proposals (RFP) for a third-party organization to assist in  
40 developing a portfolio-based sponsor evaluation framework to  
41 determine performance of community school sponsors.

42 - Requires the selected organization to work with  
43 stakeholders to develop a proposal and submit its proposed  
44 framework to the General Assembly by June 30, 2024.
