- 19 (B) (1) A licensed school counselor serving students in any 20 of grades seven through twelve shall complete four hours of training developed under this section every five years. This 21 22 training shall qualify toward meeting professional development activity requirements for the renewal of a pupil services 23 24 license in school counseling. - 44 R.C. 3319.2213
- Removes the provisions of the bill that do the following:
- 46 - Codifies the State Board of Education's 47 establishing eligibility requirements for the issuance of an initial professional pupil services license in school counseling 48 49 and adds a new requirement that an applicant complete 12 hours 50 of training about the building and construction trades that must 51 be completed at a construction site or a trade training 52 facility.
- Requires an individual who holds a school counselor license to complete at least four hours of training about the building and construction trades at a construction site or trade training facility to renew that license. Permits the four hours of training to count toward meeting continuing education requirements for licensure renewal.
 - Instead requires the State Board of Education to enter into an agreement with a construction trades organization, such as Affiliated Construction Trades (ACT) Ohio, to develop a training program to educate school counselors about job opportunities for boilermakers, electrical workers, bricklayers, insulators, laborers, iron workers, plumbers and pipefitters, roofers, plasters and cement masons, sheet metal workers, painters and glazers, elevator constructors, operating engineers, carpenters, and teamsters and available apprenticeships that must be completed by school counselors who serve students in grades 7-12.
 - Requires a licensed school counselor that serves students in grades 7-12 to complete four hours of training every five years, but permits an individual who is in the last two years of the individual's five-year renewal period to complete this training during the next renewal period.
- Qualifies those training hours toward meeting professional development activity requirements established by the State Board licensure renewal.
- Requires local professional development committees to incorporate the training into independent professional

- development programs for school counselors that serve students 80 81 in any of grades 7-12.
- Requires participating building and construction trades to 82 ensure ample opportunities for school counselors to complete the 83 training described just above during each renewal cycle for 84 85 licensure.
- Requires participating building and construction trades 86 87 training facilities or the trade organization to bear all costs associated with this training. 88
