2 "Sec. 3319.2213. (A) The state board of education shall
3 enter into an agreement with a construction trade organization
4 located in this state, such as affiliated construction trades
5 (ACT) Ohio, or its successor organization, to develop a training
6 program to educate school counselors about building and
7 construction trades career pathways.

8 A training program developed under this section shall be
9 completed at a building and construction trades training
10 facility and include information about both of the following:

11 (1) The pay and benefits available to people who work in
12 the building and construction trades;

13 (2) Job opportunities and available apprenticeships for
14 boilermakers, electrical workers, bricklayers, insulators,
15 laborers, iron workers, plumbers and pipefitters, roofers,
16 plasterers and cement masons, sheet metal workers, painters and
17 glazers, elevator constructors, operating engineers, carpenters,
18 and teamsters.

19 (B) (1) A licensed school counselor serving students in any
20 of grades seven through twelve shall complete four hours of
21 training developed under this section every five years. This
22 training shall qualify toward meeting professional development
23 activity requirements for the renewal of a pupil services
24 license in school counseling. An individual who begins working
25 with students in any of grades seven through twelve in the last
26 two years of the individual's five-year renewal cycle shall
27 complete this requirement during the following license renewal
28 cycle.

29 (2) Local professional development committees established
30 under section 3319.22 of the Revised Code shall incorporate this
31 training as part of the independent professional development
32 programs for school counselors that serve students in any of
33 grades seven through twelve.

34 (C) Participating building and construction trades shall
35 ensure ample opportunities for school counselors to complete the
36 training prescribed under this section during each renewal cycle
37 for licensure. Participating building and construction trades
38 training facilities or the entity with which the state board
39 enters into an agreement under this section shall bear all costs
40 associated with this training."

SYNOPSIS

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School counseling license training programs

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R.C. 3319.2213

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Removes the provisions of the bill that do the following:

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- Codifies the State Board of Education's rules establishing eligibility requirements for the issuance of an initial professional pupil services license in school counseling and adds a new requirement that an applicant complete 12 hours of training about the building and construction trades that must be completed at a construction site or a trade training facility.

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- Requires an individual who holds a school counselor license to complete at least four hours of training about the building and construction trades at a construction site or trade training facility to renew that license. Permits the four hours of training to count toward meeting continuing education requirements for licensure renewal.

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Instead requires the State Board of Education to enter into an agreement with a construction trades organization, such as Affiliated Construction Trades (ACT) Ohio, to develop a training program to educate school counselors about job opportunities for boilermakers, electrical workers, bricklayers, insulators, laborers, iron workers, plumbers and pipefitters, roofers, plasters and cement masons, sheet metal workers, painters and glazers, elevator constructors, operating engineers, carpenters, and teamsters and available apprenticeships that must be completed by school counselors who serve students in grades 7-12.

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Requires a licensed school counselor that serves students in grades 7-12 to complete four hours of training every five years, but permits an individual who is in the last two years of the individual's five-year renewal period to complete this training during the next renewal period.

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Qualifies those training hours toward meeting professional development activity requirements established by the State Board licensure renewal.

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Requires local professional development committees to incorporate the training into independent professional

82 Requires participating building and construction trades to
83 ensure ample opportunities for school counselors to complete the
84 training described just above during each renewal cycle for
85 licensure.

86 Requires participating building and construction trades
87 training facilities or the trade organization to bear all costs
88 associated with this training.
