or out of, the Casino Control Commission Fund or other
appropriation provided by law. The members shall receive no
additional compensation, but shall be reimbursed for actual and
necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official
duties.

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(D) The ~~Committee~~ Study Commission shall submit a report of
its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly not later
than June 30, 2024. After it submits its report, the Study
Commission ceases to exist ~~on the date that is two years after the~~
~~effective date of this section.~~

SYNOPSIS

Study Commission on the Future of Gaming in Ohio

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**Sections 610.90 and 610.91 (amending Section 5 of H.B. 29 of
the 134th General Assembly); Section 610.100 (repeal of Section 5
of H.B. 29 of the 134th General Assembly)**

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Eliminates a provision of the Senate-passed bill that would
have abolished the Joint Committee on Sports Gaming created under
H.B. 29 and instead restores provisions of the House-passed bill
that do all of the following:

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- Expand the membership and duties of the Joint Committee on Sports Gaming and rename it the Study Commission on the Future of Gaming in Ohio. 70
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- Require the Study Commission to examine the status of the statewide lottery, sports gaming, casino gaming, and horse racing in Ohio and the future of those industries and to make recommendations to the General Assembly on those subjects. 73
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- Require the Study Commission to submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly by June 30, 2024. 77
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Specify that the Study Commission ceases to exist after it submits its report, extending the Joint Committee's current expiration date of March 23, 2024. 80
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
