"Sec. 3319.324. (A) As used in this section, "school records" 6  
includes any academic records, student assessment data, or other 7  
information for which there is a legitimate educational interest. 8

(B) Except as provided for in division (C) of this section, 9  
when any school district or chartered nonpublic school receives a 10  
request from another district or school to which a student has 11  
transferred for that student's school records, the district or 12  
school receiving the request shall respond, within five school 13  
days after receiving the request, by transmitting to the 14  
requesting district or school either the student's school records 15  
as authorized under section 3319.321 of the Revised Code or, if 16  
the district or school has no record of the student's attendance, 17  
a statement of that fact. 18

(C) A district or school may withhold a student's school 19

records if there is two thousand five hundred dollars or more of  
outstanding debt attributed to the student. The district or school  
shall transmit the student's school records in the manner  
specified under division (A) of this section once the debt is  
paid.

(D) The provisions of this section are in addition to, and do  
not affect the obligations of a school district or school to  
comply with, the requirements of division (D) of section 3313.642  
and section 3313.672 of the Revised Code."

**Transmission of transferred student's records**

**R.C. 3314.03, 3326.11, 3328.24, and 3319.324**

Requires public and chartered nonpublic schools to transmit a  
transferring student's school records within five school days upon  
receiving such a request.

Permits a school to withhold school records if there is  
\$2,500 or more of debt attributed to the student, but also  
requires the transmission of records if that debt is paid.

Defines school records as any academic records, student  
assessment data, or other information for which there is a  
legitimate educational interest.
