"**Sec. 4507.06.** (A)(1) Every application for a driver's 9  
license, motorcycle operator's license or endorsement, or 10  
motor-driven cycle or motor scooter license or endorsement, or 11  
duplicate of any such license or endorsement, shall be made upon 12  
the approved form furnished by the registrar of motor vehicles and 13  
shall be signed by the applicant. 14

Every application shall state the following: 15

(a) The applicant's name, date of birth, social security 16  
number if such has been assigned, sex, general description, 17  
including height, weight, color of hair, and eyes, residence 18

address, including county of residence, duration of residence in 19  
this state, and country of citizenship; 20

(b) Whether the applicant previously has been licensed as an 21  
operator, chauffeur, driver, commercial driver, or motorcycle 22  
operator and, if so, when, by what state, and whether such license 23  
is suspended or canceled at the present time and, if so, the date 24  
of and reason for the suspension or cancellation; 25

(c) Whether the applicant is now or ever has been afflicted 26  
with epilepsy, or whether the applicant now has any physical or 27  
mental disability or disease and, if so, the nature and extent of 28  
the disability or disease, giving the names and addresses of 29  
physicians then or previously in attendance upon the applicant; 30

(d) Whether an applicant for a duplicate driver's license, 31  
duplicate license containing a motorcycle operator endorsement, or 32  
duplicate license containing a motor-driven cycle or motor scooter 33  
endorsement has pending a citation for violation of any motor 34  
vehicle law or ordinance, a description of any such citation 35  
pending, and the date of the citation; 36

(e) If an applicant has not certified the applicant's 37  
willingness to make an anatomical gift under section 2108.05 of 38  
the Revised Code, whether the applicant wishes to certify 39  
willingness to make such an anatomical gift, which shall be given 40  
no consideration in the issuance of a license or endorsement; 41

(f) Whether the applicant has executed a valid durable power 42  
of attorney for health care pursuant to sections 1337.11 to 43  
1337.17 of the Revised Code or has executed a declaration 44  
governing the use or continuation, or the withholding or 45  
withdrawal, of life-sustaining treatment pursuant to sections 46  
2133.01 to 2133.15 of the Revised Code and, if the applicant has 47  
executed either type of instrument, whether the applicant wishes 48

the applicant's license to indicate that the applicant has  
executed the instrument;

(g) Whether the applicant is a veteran, active duty, or  
reservist of the armed forces of the United States and, if the  
applicant is such, whether the applicant wishes the applicant's  
license to indicate that the applicant is a veteran, active duty,  
or reservist of the armed forces of the United States by a  
military designation on the license.

(2) Every applicant for a driver's license applying in person  
at a deputy registrar office shall be photographed ~~in color~~ at the  
time the application for the license is made. The application  
shall state any additional information that the registrar  
requires.

(B) The registrar or a deputy registrar, in accordance with  
section 3503.11 of the Revised Code, shall register as an elector  
any person who applies for a license or endorsement under division  
(A) of this section, or for a renewal or duplicate of the license  
or endorsement, if the applicant is eligible and wishes to be  
registered as an elector. The decision of an applicant whether to  
register as an elector shall be given no consideration in the  
decision of whether to issue the applicant a license or  
endorsement, or a renewal or duplicate.

(C) The registrar or a deputy registrar, in accordance with  
section 3503.11 of the Revised Code, shall offer the opportunity  
of completing a notice of change of residence or change of name to  
any applicant for a driver's license or endorsement under division  
(A) of this section, or for a renewal or duplicate of the license  
or endorsement, if the applicant is a registered elector who has  
changed the applicant's residence or name and has not filed such a  
notice.

(D) In addition to any other information it contains, the approved form furnished by the registrar of motor vehicles for an application for a license or endorsement or an application for a duplicate of any such license or endorsement shall inform applicants that the applicant must present a copy of the applicant's DD-214 or an equivalent document in order to qualify to have the license or duplicate indicate that the applicant is a veteran, active duty, or reservist of the armed forces of the United States based on a request made pursuant to division (A)(1)(g) of this section."

**"Sec. 4507.18.** (A) The registrar of motor vehicles shall permit all of the following to renew a driver's license or motorcycle operator's endorsement issued by this state by electronic means:

(1) Any person who is on active duty in the armed forces of the United States who is stationed outside of this state;

(2) The spouse of a person described in division (A)(1) of this section who is also outside of this state;

(3) The dependents of a person described in division (A)(1) of this section who are also outside of this state.

(B) The registrar shall require all of the following:

(1) That the applicant provide a digital copy of the applicant's military identification card or military dependent identification card;

(2) That any spouse or dependent applicant provide a digital copy of a form provided by the registrar demonstrating that the

applicant received and passed a vision examination in accordance 107  
with the vision requirements under section 4507.12 of the Revised 108  
Code; 109

(3) That the applicant provide a digital copy of a current 110  
two inch by two inch ~~color~~ passport quality photograph with a 111  
white background to be used as the applicant's new driver's 112  
license or motorcycle operator's endorsement photograph; 113

(4) That the applicant provide a digital copy of any 114  
identification documents and supporting documents as required by 115  
statute or administrative rule to comply with current state and 116  
federal requirements. 117

(C) The registrar shall make it possible for applicants to 118  
upload and send by electronic means all required copies of 119  
supporting documents and photographs for a driver's license or 120  
motorcycle operator's endorsement renewal under this section. 121

(D)(1) This section does not impact a person's ability to use 122  
the exemption from the license requirements available under 123  
division (B) of section 4507.03 of the Revised Code. 124

(2) This section does not prevent a person who is permitted 125  
to renew a driver's license or motorcycle operator's endorsement 126  
by electronic means under this section from making an application, 127  
as provided in section 4507.10 of the Revised Code, in person at a 128  
deputy ~~registrar~~ registrar's office. 129

(E) The registrar shall adopt rules under Chapter 119. of the 130  
Revised Code to implement and administer this section." 131

"**Sec. 4507.51.** (A)(1) Every application for an identification 133  
card or duplicate shall be made on a form furnished or in a manner 134

specified by the registrar of motor vehicles, shall be signed by 135  
the applicant, and by the applicant's parent or guardian if the 136  
applicant is under eighteen years of age, and shall contain the 137  
following information pertaining to the applicant: name, date of 138  
birth, sex, general description including the applicant's height, 139  
weight, hair color, and eye color, address, country of 140  
citizenship, and social security number. The application also 141  
shall include, for an applicant who has not already certified the 142  
applicant's willingness to make an anatomical gift under section 143  
2108.05 of the Revised Code, whether the applicant wishes to 144  
certify willingness to make such an anatomical gift and shall 145  
include information about the requirements of sections 2108.01 to 146  
2108.29 of the Revised Code that apply to persons who are less 147  
than eighteen years of age. The statement regarding willingness to 148  
make such a donation shall be given no consideration in the 149  
decision of whether to issue an identification card. Each 150  
applicant applying in person at a deputy registrar office shall be 151  
photographed ~~in color~~ at the time of making application. 152

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(2)(a) The application also shall state whether the applicant 154  
has executed a valid durable power of attorney for health care 155  
pursuant to sections 1337.11 to 1337.17 of the Revised Code or has 156  
executed a declaration governing the use or continuation, or the 157  
withholding or withdrawal, of life-sustaining treatment pursuant 158  
to sections 2133.01 to 2133.15 of the Revised Code and, if the 159  
applicant has executed either type of instrument, whether the 160  
applicant wishes the identification card issued to indicate that 161  
the applicant has executed the instrument. 162

(b) The application also shall state whether the applicant is 163  
a veteran, active duty, or reservist of the armed forces of the 164

United States and, if the applicant is such, whether the applicant  
wishes the identification card issued to indicate that the  
applicant is a veteran, active duty, or reservist of the armed  
forces of the United States by a military designation on the  
identification card.

(3) The registrar or deputy registrar, in accordance with  
section 3503.11 of the Revised Code, shall register as an elector  
any person who applies for an identification card or duplicate if  
the applicant is eligible and wishes to be registered as an  
elector. The decision of an applicant whether to register as an  
elector shall be given no consideration in the decision of whether  
to issue the applicant an identification card or duplicate.

(B) Except as provided in section 4507.061 of the Revised  
Code, the application for an identification card or duplicate  
shall be filed in the office of the registrar or deputy registrar.  
Each applicant shall present documentary evidence as required by  
the registrar of the applicant's age and identity, and the  
applicant shall swear that all information given is true. An  
identification card issued by the department of rehabilitation and  
correction under section 5120.59 of the Revised Code or an  
identification card issued by the department of youth services  
under section 5139.511 of the Revised Code shall be sufficient  
documentary evidence under this division upon verification of the  
applicant's social security number by the registrar or a deputy  
registrar. Upon issuing an identification card under this section  
for a person who has been issued an identification card under  
section 5120.59 or section 5139.511 of the Revised Code, the  
registrar or deputy registrar shall destroy the identification  
card issued under section 5120.59 or section 5139.511 of the  
Revised Code.

All applications for an identification card or duplicate under this section shall be filed in duplicate, and if submitted to a deputy registrar, a copy shall be forwarded to the registrar. The registrar shall prescribe rules for the manner in which a deputy registrar is to file and maintain applications and other records. The registrar shall maintain a suitable, indexed record of all applications denied and cards issued or canceled.

(C) In addition to any other information it contains, the form furnished by the registrar of motor vehicles for an application for an identification card or duplicate shall inform applicants that the applicant must present a copy of the applicant's DD-214 or an equivalent document in order to qualify to have the card or duplicate indicate that the applicant is an honorably discharged veteran of the armed forces of the United States based on a request made pursuant to division (A)(2)(b) of this section."

**R.C. 4506.11, 4507.01, 4507.06, 4507.13, 4507.18, 4507.51, and 4507.52**



Restores provisions from the House-passed version of the bill 219  
that remove the requirement that the photograph displayed on a 220  
driver's license, CDL, or state ID card, and generally taken by 221  
the Registrar or deputy registrar, be in color (conforming the law 222  
to current practice). 223
