32 **Parental leave benefits**

33 **R.C. 124.136**

34 Restores the proposed increase in parental leave benefits  
35 for certain state employees to the As Passed by the House  
36 version, which results in a total of 12 weeks of leave paid at  
37 the current rate of 70% of the employee's base rate of pay (it  
38 does so by eliminating the current 14-day unpaid waiting period  
39 and tripling the current paid leave period).

40 **Employee Benefits Funds**

41 **Sections 271.10 and 271.20**

42 Increases appropriations under Fund 8110 ALI 995671,  
43 Parental Leave Benefit Fund, by \$2,312,119 in FY 2024 and  
44 \$4,097,759 in FY 2025.

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45           Allows eligible employees to receive paid parental leave  
46 under sections 124.136 and 124.137 of the Revised Code for a  
47 period of up to 12 weeks, inclusive of the two-week waiting  
48 period.
